## UNKNOWN BANK BREAK-IN SUBJECT

### DESCRIPTION

**Sex:** Male

**Build:** Medium

**Race:** Black

**Clothing/Disguise:** Surveillance video captured footage of a subject wearing a white Tyvek suit and a blue baseball hat. In the second break-in, the subject(s) did not disguise their appearance.

### CAUTION

At approximately 2:00 AM on Friday, August 24, 2012, one or more subjects broke into a vacated business located at 1420 Wisconsin Avenue, NW, Washington, District of Columbia. The subject(s) cut through a wall in order to enter the bank, gaining access to a room that housed the bank's ATM. When an alarm sounded, Metropolitan Police Department responded to the scene, however, the subject(s) had already fled. No items were found to have been missing from the bank.

The August 24, 2012, break-in is similar to two other break-ins that occurred at the Bank of America located at 2631 Connecticut Avenue, NW. In the overnight hours of Friday, August 17, 2012, and Tuesday, May 24, 2011, one or more subject(s) broke in to a vacated business located at 2633 Connecticut Avenue, NW, and into the adjacent Bank of America, causing structural damage.

The FBI's Violent Crimes Task Force is investigating this bank break-in with the Metropolitan Police Department and requests that anyone with information call the FBI at 202-278-2000 or MPD at 202-727-9099.
