The suspect was also wearing dark colored shoes with a white bottom.

CAUTION

On Wednesday, July 18, 2012, at approximately 2:45 pm, an unknown male entered the PNC Bank at 650 Pennsylvania Avenue SE, Washington, D.C. and verbally demanded money. After obtaining a sum of money from the teller, the subject exited the bank. This subject is also suspected of allegedly robbing the Capital One Bank at 210 Michigan Avenue NE, Washington, D.C. on August 1, 2012.

SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS
