UNKNOWN BANK ROBBERS



DESCRIPTION

Height: Suspect#1 - 5'2" to 5'5";
Suspect#2 - 5'10" to 6'0"

Sex: Male

Complexion: Medium

Age: 20s to 30s

Clothing/Disguise: The suspects wore jeans, button down western dress shirts, ties, latex gloves, ball caps or hats, neon construction safety vests, and boots. The suspects carried one black duffel bag and two "bank closed" signs with tape.

Weapon Used: The suspects had black automatic handguns.

Weight: Suspect#1 - Approximately 165 pounds; Suspect#2 - Approximately 175 pounds

Build: Medium

Race: White (Hispanic)

CAUTION

On October 27, 2012, at approximately 9:20 a.m., two Hispanic males, in their 20s to 30s, entered Centennial Bank on Bowman Road in Little Rock, Arkansas. They wore dress shirts, ties, blue jeans, ball caps, matching construction vests in neon yellow, latex gloves and work boots. One Hispanic male was considerably short, approximately 5'2" to 5'5", the other was approximately 5'9" to 6'0". Both robbers were armed with black automatic handguns. One robber had a black duffel bag. The robbers used laser printed "bank closed" signs, with the bank's watermark on it. They taped the signs to the entrance doors. The robbers used white zip ties on the employees to restrain their hands during the robbery. They fled the bank on foot and were last observed going north on Bowman Road.
