UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



DESCRIPTION

Remarks: Suspect #1 is described as a Black male with a large build. He was approximately 6'0", weighed approximately 220 to 250 pounds and was approximately 20 to 30 years old. The suspect wore a black hooded jacket with the hood up, a black mask across his face, and dark pants. He held a black handgun. Suspect#2 is described as a White male with a small to medium build. He was approximately 5'8" to 5'9", weighing 150 to 180 pounds and was approximately 20 to 30 years old. The suspect wore a black hooded jacket with the hood up, a black mask across his face, and blue jeans. He carried a tan or green-colored bag.

Weapon Used: A black handgun

CAUTION

On February 12, 2013, at approximately 11:00 AM, two male suspects entered the Cooper State Bank located at 1669 West 5th Avenue, Columbus, Ohio. The suspects demanded that an employee open the cash drawer and give them cash. The employee placed the cash in a tan or green-colored bag and the suspects fled, running west from the bank.
