## UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** 5'6" to 5'7"

**Sex:** Male

**Race:** White

**Age:** Mid to late 30s

**Remarks:** The suspect wore a dark blue baseball cap with the letters 'NY' on the front of it, large-framed eye glasses, a blue hooded shirt, and gray pants that appeared to be sweatpants.

**Vehicle Information:** Video surveillance shows the suspect leaving the bank and walking south before entering the front passenger side of a red, two-door Chevy (possibly a Chevy Cobalt) with a clean body and a sun roof. The vehicle crossed Marble Avenue and entered the Saw Mill River Parkway.

### CAUTION

On Monday, April 15, 2013, at 3:46 p.m., a White male entered the Hudson Valley Bank located at 501 Marble Avenue in Pleasantville, New York. He approached teller window number two and passed a white piece of paper through the teller tray. Written on the paper was the following: "No alarms. No dye packs. Give me all the cash." The teller did not have any cash to give the suspect, and he became very upset and told the teller to give him the note back. The teller gave the suspect the note, noting that he spoke unusually slowly. No cash was handed over.
