## UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** 5'5" to 5'9"

**Sex:** Male

**Build:** Small

**Hair:** Black

**Complexion:** Dark

**Race:** Black

**Age:** 20 to 30 years old

**Remarks:** The suspect had a black ponytail, which could have been a wig, and a light mustache. He was wearing dark-rimmed glasses with clear frames, a black and gray striped long-sleeve shirt, dark pants and a dark baseball cap with the Under Armour logo.

**Vehicle Information:** A dark colored four-door sedan with out-of-state license plates. The license plates were white with red digits.

### CAUTION

On Monday, August 2, 2010, at approximately 8:40 a.m., the JP Morgan Chase Bank located at 273 Columbus Avenue in Tuckahoe, New York, was robbed. The bank is located directly across from the Crestwood Train Station. An unidentified subject entered the bank and approached a bank teller. He handed the teller a gray and black Nike bag that had draw strings and appeared to be made of either nylon or canvass. He told the teller to fill up the bag and to fill her bag as well. The suspect gestured that he had a weapon in his pocket, but a weapon was not displayed. He fled with an unkown amount of cash and was seen entering a dark colored four-door sedan with out-of-state license plates. The license plates were white with red digits. The vehicle was driven by an accomplice, and it was last seen traveling northbound on Columbus Avenue toward the Leewood Tunnel.
