DESCRIPTION

Sex: Male

Race: Black

Age: 25 to 30

Remarks: The subject wore a camouflage hooded sweatshirt, jeans, and a monkey mask.

Vehicle Information: The subject was last observed entering the passenger side of a dark brown, two-door vehicle with a black spoiler on the back and a bright red plate on the front with white or silver writing. The vehicle was described as being similar to a Mitsubishi Eclipse.

Weapon Used: The weapon was described as a small, silver automatic handgun.

CAUTION

On November 20, 2012, at 2:38pm, the Bank of the Ozarks located at 13415 Otter Creek Parkway in Little Rock, Arkansas, was robbed. Upon entry the subject pointed a handgun towards the bank employees and a customer and orally demanded money. After placing the money inside the camouflage sweatshirt pockets, the subject departed the bank on foot and was later observed entering the passenger side of a dark brown, two-door vehicle, described as being similar to a Mitsubishi Eclipse, with a black spoiler on the back and a bright red plate on the front with white or silver writing.
