UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER

DESCRIPTION

Height: Approximately 6'0" - 6'2"

Sex: Male

Build: Skinny

Complexion: Dark

Race: Black

Age: Approximately 20s - mid 30s

Remarks: The robber wore a black long-sleeved jacket with an unknown design on the back and white stripes around the cuffs of the jacket. He also wore a white teeshirt underneath the jacket, jeans and dark-colored shoes. The "teddy bear hat" was described as a light brown fur hat with furry ears and a tail.

Weapon Used: Pistol

CAUTION

At approximately 6:34 am, the "Teddy Bear Bandit" forced his way into the J.P. Morgan Chase Bank, located at 4165 FM 1960, Houston, Texas, while tellers were preparing to open the bank to the public. No customers were inside the bank at the time of the robbery. Armed with a pistol, the robber physically assaulted one of the tellers with his gun. The teller sustained minor injuries from the assault. He also fired several gunshots into a wall of the bank. The robber did get away with an undisclosed amount of cash.
