The suspect also carried a designer handbag with a black "G" print on a white or beige background with black trim and black handles.

### CAUTION

On Friday, July 5, 2013, at approximately 1:08 p.m., a Black female suspect entered the Chase Bank located at 2866 W March Lane, in Stockton, California. She approached a teller, brandished a handgun, and demanded money. The suspect fled the bank after receiving money from the teller. The suspect also robbed the same Chase Bank on January 19, 2013. Additionally, the suspect is believed to be responsible for robbing a Wells Fargo Bank in Fresno, California, on February 2, 2013, and an attempted robbery of a Citizens Business Bank in Bakersfield, California, on January 17, 2013.
