DESCRIPTION

Remarks: In both robberies, the unknown subject wore a tan fedora with a black band, sunglasses, and either a tan blazer or a sweater.

Vehicle Information: Possibly a late-model black four-door Lexus.

Weapon Used: In both robberies, the unknown subject motioned to his waistband area to imply that he had a gun, but a gun was never displayed.

Weight: 170 to 185 pounds

CAUTION

On October 11, 2013, the First Tennessee Bank located within the Kroger Store at 9050 Highway 64 in Lakeland, Tennessee, was robbed by an unknown suspect. The unknown subject presented a robbery demand note to the victim teller demanding \$3,000 in large bills. The unknown subject stated that his girlfriend was being held for ransom. On October 18, 2013, at the Suntrust Bank located within the Kroger Store at 540 South Mendenhall in Memphis, Tennessee, the same unknown subject presented a robbery demand note to the victim teller demanding \$5,000 in large bills. In both robberies, the unknown subject posed as a customer and waited in line until a teller was available.

REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the individual responsible for these robberies.
