DESCRIPTION

Height: Approximately 5'7" to 6'0" **Sex:** Male
Build: Thin **Eyes:** Brown
Hair: Dark **Race:** Black
Age: Mid-20s

Remarks: On October 17, 2013, the subject wore a black hooded sweatshirt with a dark shirt underneath with white lettering, a white ball cap with an emblem on the front, and black and white shoes. He carried a black cell phone. On October 31, 2013, the subject wore a grey hooded sweatshirt, blue shirt underneath, black baseball style hat, black pants, and black and white high top tennis shoes.

Weapon Used: Black handgun

CAUTION

On October 17, 2013, at approximately 3:30 P.M., a Black male entered the Chase Bank located at 186 Graceland Boulevard in Columbus, Ohio. The subject approached the teller, advised that he was robbing the bank and allegedly demanded money. The subject displayed a handgun in his waistband. The teller handed currency to the subject, who immediately exited the front door of the bank. The subject was last seen walking southeast through the bank parking lot.

On October 31, 2013, at approximately 2:04 P.M., a subject entered the WesBanco branch located at 116 S. Stygler Road, Gahanna, Ohio. The subject walked directly to the teller counter and verbally demanded money from the teller and displayed a black handgun. The subject allegedly retrieved U.S. currency from several of the tellers before exiting the bank on foot. The subject was described as a Black male, 5'7" to 5'10", medium build, spoke with an African accent, mid 20s in age, wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt, blue shirt underneath, black baseball style hat, black pants and black and white high top tennis shoes.
