DESCRIPTION

Height: 5'5" to 5'8"

Weight: Approximately 140 to 150
pounds

Build: Small

Race: Black

Age: Approximately 20 to 30 years
old

Remarks: The unknown suspect is described as a black male or transgender female. The suspect dresses like a woman and carries a purse. The suspect wears different colored wigs during the robberies. The unknown suspect's accomplice is described as a black female who wore dark clothing.

Vehicle Information: Newer model black sedan, possibly a Chevrolet Impala

CAUTION

The unknown suspect allegedly robbed a Liberty Bank in New Orleans, Louisiana, on June 22, 2012, at approximately 12:00 p.m. The unknown suspect also entered a Whitney Bank in New Orleans on July 13, 2012. The suspect left that bank after seeing a New Orleans Police Department Officer working a detail at the bank. Then, on July 14, 2012, at approximately 10:41 a.m., the unknown suspect allegedly robbed a Capital One Bank in New Orleans. In each robbery, the suspect presented a demand note, which implied he/she had a gun in his/her purse.

During the July 13, 2012 attempted robbery of the Whitney Bank, an unidentified black female entered the bank prior to the unknown suspect, but did not conduct any transactions. It is believed that the unidentified black female and the unknown suspect were working together, that she is the unknown suspect's accomplice. The unknown suspect's accomplice was seen driving a black sedan, possibly a newer model Chevrolet Impala.
