### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** Approximately 5'10" to 6'2"    **Weight:** Approximately 250 to 300 pounds

**Sex:** Male

**Build:** Large

**Race:** Black

**Age:** Approximately in his 20s to 30s

**Weapon Used:** Silver semi-automatic pistol with a black handle.

### CAUTION

An unknown suspect has robbed four banks in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in the last six months, including robbing the same bank three times. The subject has worn a different disguise in each of the robberies and has been dubbed the "Back Fence Bandit" because his escape has repeatedly involved scaling a fence behind a bank into a gated condominium complex.

On May 13, 2013, the Bank of Oklahoma located at 11300 North May Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was robbed. During this robbery, the subject wore a surgical cap, sunglasses, and appeared to have gauze and/or makeup on his face. The subject stated he had a gun, although none was seen.

On July 15, 2013, the Bank of Oklahoma located at 11300 North May Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was robbed a second time. During this robbery, the subject wore a fake beard and dreadlocks, a straw hat with a small brim, and sunglasses. The subject displayed a semi-automatic pistol during the robbery.

On September 27, 2013, the Bank of Oklahoma located at 2601 North Meridian in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was robbed. During this robbery, the subject wore an orange construction-type safety vest, an orange head covering, a skull face mask and skeleton hand gloves.

On November 29, 2013, the Bank of Oklahoma located at 11300 North May in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, was robbed for the third time. During this robbery, the subject wore an "old man" mask (White with red lips) and a gray-and-white cap. The subject displayed a silver semi-automatic pistol with black handle during this robbery.

**SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS**
