DESCRIPTION

Height: 5'7" to 5'8"

Remarks: The unknown suspect wore a black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans and white tennis shoes with purple soles and laces. The suspect had a red bandana over his face. In the first robbery, the suspect wore flip-up sunglasses, and bandages or tape over his fingertips.

Weapon Used: In the January 21st robbery, a witness observed the subject flashing a silver handgun.

Weight: 150 to 160 pounds

Build: Medium

CAUTION

On December 18, 2013, an unknown suspect allegedly robbed the Bank of Oklahoma located at 7101 Northwest 23rd Street in Bethany, Oklahoma (inside the Homeland Grocery). The suspect stated "This is a robbery. I have a gun. Give me all your money." The suspect threatened to harm the teller if she did not follow his instructions. The teller complied with the demand and provided the subject with an undisclosed amount of money. The subject placed the money in a plastic grocery bag and was last seen exiting the Homeland Grocery on foot.

On January 21, 2014, the same Bank of Oklahoma was allegedly robbed by an individual that authorities believe to be the same suspect from the December 18th robbery.

SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS
