## UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



### DESCRIPTION

**Remarks:** The robber in the composite is described as a Black male, approximately late 20s-early 30s, 5'8" – 5'11", 200 – 230 pounds, tall and husky. He wore a blue jogging suit. The second robber is described as a Black male, approximately late 20s – early 30s, 6'2" and 230 pounds. He wore a yellow hooded sweatshirt and black jogging pants.

**Vehicle Information:** A stolen white minivan was recovered a short distance from the bank.

**Weapon Used:** The robber in the composite was armed with a pistol. The second robber carried a shotgun.

### CAUTION

At about 10:30 a.m., a man armed with a shotgun and another armed with a pistol, entered the J.P. Morgan Chase bank, located at 19507 Interstate 45 North, Spring, Texas, and demanded cash. After receiving an undisclosed amount of cash, they fled in a stolen white minivan that was recovered a short distance from the bank. No one was physically hurt.
