Remarks: The suspect wore a black hooded sweatshirt with the hood covering his head, dark "aviator"-style sunglasses, a white bandana covering his face, gray gloves, gray sweatpants, and black athletic shoes with white trim.

Vehicle Information: It was reported that a white sports utility vehicle, possibly a Cadillac Escalade or Nissan Xterra, was seen fleeing the scene after the robbery.

Weapon Used: Handgun

CAUTION

On June 27, 2013 at approximately 10 a.m., the suspect entered the Bank of America at 2000 Central Avenue in McKinleyville, California. During the robbery, the suspect brandished a handgun, approached the teller counter, made a verbal demand for money and jumped over the counter to place the stolen money in a white trash bag.
