CAUTION

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest of a serial bank robber who robbed four banks in Prince George's County (Maryland) and the District of Columbia between May 29, 2014, and June 18, 2014. The unidentified man passed notes to tellers demanding money. In one robbery, he verbally told the teller he was armed with a gun. Witnesses describe the robber as a Black man, about 35 to 40 years old, around 5'8" to 5'10" tall, and weighing between 170 and 200 pounds. He was observed wearing some sort of hat and sunglasses and wore a suit jacket in three of the robberies.

The following bank locations were robbed on the dates indicated: May 29, 2014 — BB&T, 6410 Allentown Road, Camp Springs, Maryland; June 12, 2014 - Wells Fargo Bank, 3325 10th Street NW, Washington, D.C.; June 12, 2014 — Wells Fargo Bank, 3200 Pennsylvania Avenue SE, Washington, D.C.; June 18, 2014 — BB&T, 9412 Livingston Road, Fort Washington, Maryland.
