## UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



### DESCRIPTION

**Sex:** Male

**Race:** White

**Age:** 50s to 60s

**Remarks:** The individual was described as a White male in his 50s to 60s. He was wearing a dark-colored plaid jacket with a camouflage hat and blue jeans.

**Weapon Used:** The individual brandished a weapon.

### CAUTION

On Friday, October 31, 2014, at approximately 11:30 a.m., an unknown individual entered the Suntrust bank located at 11 Pidgeon Hill Drive, in Sterling, Virginia. He approached a teller, brandished a firearm and demanded money. Upon receiving an undisclosed amount of currency, he fled the bank on foot.

### REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information that leads to the identification, arrest and conviction of this bank robber.
