On Saturday, November 8, 2014, at approximately 10:21 a.m., the North Shore Bank located at 5817 West Forest Home Avenue in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was robbed. The suspect entered the bank, approached the teller and provided them a demand note. The note advised the suspect had a firearm, he showed the teller a silver-colored handgun located in the waistband of his pants. The suspect was provided the money and then exited the bank.
