DESCRIPTION

Height: Between 5'10" - 6'2"

Weight: Approximately 165 - 190 pounds

Sex: Male

Build: Thin

Race: White

Remarks: In both the January 2015 and December 2014 robberies, the robber covered his face with a black ski mask. He also covered his head with a baseball cap and the hood from his hoodie, pulled up over the cap. He wore one glove, over his right hand, during the January 2015 robbery and wore gloves over both hands during the December 2014 robbery.

Vehicle Information: During the January 2015 robbery, the robber used a beach cruiser type bicycle once he exited the bank. The robber was then observed loading the bicycle into the back of a white SUV. During the December 2014 robbery, the robber used a metal gray-colored BMX-style bicycle which was low to the ground.

Weapon Used: During the January 2015 robbery, the robber threatened the use of a bomb and held a small device in his hand which clicked. He also displayed and threatened the use of a black handgun. During the December 2014 robbery, he threatened the use of a bomb; no handgun was displayed or threatened.

CAUTION

On Tuesday, January 6, 2015 an unknown male robbed the US Bank branch, located at 2520 El Camino Real, Carlsbad, California, at approximately 2:30 p.m. The robber approached the victim teller, displayed a black handgun and demanded all the money the teller had available. The robber also threatened the use of a bomb while holding a white device in one hand which made clicking noises. No injuries were reported.

After receiving a sum of money, the robber exited the bank and was seen riding away on a dark-colored beach cruiser-type bicycle. The robber then approached a sports utility vehicle (SUV), which appeared to be waiting for

the robber, and loaded the bicycle into the back. The small, white, SUV was driving by an unknown female driver. It had a hatchback with black stripes on the side and no visible license plates.

On Tuesday, December 23, 2014, at approximately 4:15 p.m. a lone male robbed the US Bank branch, located at 4136 Oceanside Boulevard, Oceanside, California. The suspect approached the victim teller, threatened the use of a bomb, and demanded money from the cash drawers. No injuries were reported.

After receiving a sum of money, the robber fled southbound across Oceanside Boulevard toward a rail station. The subject rode a BMX-style bicycle that was low to the ground and a metal gray color.
