UNKNOWN ATTEMPTED BANK ROBBER



DESCRIPTION

Sex: Male

Build: Medium

Complexion: Medium

Race: Black

Age: 30 to 35 years old

Remarks: The subject was described as wearing a uniform resembling that of a building security officer which consisted of dark colored pants, a blue button-down long-sleeved shirt with a red patch on the sleeve and a dark colored tie. He was also wearing a dark colored knit hat with the Washington Redskins logo, a black backpack over both shoulders and a light blue medical mask trimmed in white over his mouth.

CAUTION

On Wednesday, December 24, 2014, at approximately 1:30 p.m., a male subject attempted to rob the Citibank located at 1400 G Street in Northwest Washington, D.C. The subject approached the victim teller, verbally implied that he had a weapon and demanded money. The subject exited the bank without receiving any money.

REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information that leads to the identification, arrest and conviction of this attempted bank robber.
