DESCRIPTION

Remarks: In the January 20, 2015 robbery, the suspect wore his facial hair in a beard. He wore a grey beanie with white stripe, a light blue t-shirt with "Harley Davidson" printed on the front with a grey shirt underneath, white and grey board shorts in a plaid pattern, and white tennis shoes with possibly neon yellow shoelaces. During the January 22, 2015 robbery, the suspect wore a black baseball hat, black-framed prescription glasses, a black short-sleeve polo-style shirt, dark-colored board shorts, and black and white tennis shoes.

Vehicle Information: During the January 20, 2015 robbery, a small, white vehicle was observed.

Weight: 150 to 175 pounds

Build: Thin

CAUTION

On January 20th, 2015, at approximately 1:28 pm, an unknown suspect entered the Wal-Mart store located at 4617 East Bell Road in Phoenix, Arizona, and proceeded to the 1st Convenience Bank inside. Once there, he approached the teller counter and stated he needed to make a deposit. The suspect then produced a demand note for a specific amount of money. The teller complied and gave the suspect currency. The suspect then fled the store through the east doors. Wal-Mart's surveillance cameras captured the suspect fleeing to a small, white passenger car in the parking lot.

On January 22, 2015, at approximately 5:10 pm, the suspect entered the Chase Bank located at 8200 E. Via Paseo Del Norte in Scottsdale, Arizona, and proceeded to the teller counter. There, he inquired about opening an account and presented a robbery demand note to the teller. The teller gave the suspect currency. The suspect fled the bank and was not located.
