CAUTION

Unknown subjects have committed three takeover-style bank robberies in the North Hills section of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1.) January 24, 2015: Citizens Bank, 4761 Route 8, Allison Park Pennsylvania 15104
- 2.) February 21, 2015: Huntington Bank, 8090 McKnight Road, McCandless, Pennsylvania 15237
- 3.) April 10, 2015: First Niagara Bank: 6203 Babcock Boulevard, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15237

The level of violence appears to be increasing. In all three robberies, the suspects wore ski masks, gloves, hooded sweatshirts, and sweatpants over another layer of clothing.

REWARD

A reward in the amount of up to \$10,000 is being offered by the FBI for any information leading to the apprehension of these individuals.
