UNKNOWN ATTEMPTED BANK ROBBER



DESCRIPTION

Height: Approximately 5'6" to 5'8"

Weight: Approximately 120 to 140 pounds

Sex: Male

Build: Small

Race: Black

Age: Approximately 22 to 28 years old

Remarks: The suspect wore a tan baseball cap, a black jacket, dark-colored jeans, and wire-rimmed sunglasses. The suspect carried a black backpack-style bag.

Weapon Used: A medium-sized black semiautomatic handgun

CAUTION

On Monday, May 18, 2015, at approximately 9:27 a.m., the Wells Fargo Bank located at 3323 West Villard Avenue in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, was the victim of an attempted robbery.

The suspect entered the bank behind a customer and when the customer proceeded to ask a bank employee a question, the suspect grabbed the customer and produced a semiautomatic handgun. The suspect continued to hold the customer while demanding money from the bank employees. The suspect exited the bank after being informed that the bank did not have money and fled westbound through an alley.
