### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** 5'5" to 5'7"

**Sex:** Male

**Vehicle Information:** 2004-2010 black or dark grey Nissan Titan pickup truck.

**Weapon Used:** Small black semi-automatic pistol with an exposed hammer.

**Weight:** 180 pounds

### CAUTION

On June 6, 2015, at approximately 9:33 a.m., the suspect entered the TCF Bank located at 6020 South 35th Avenue in Phoenix, Arizona, and approached the teller counter. The suspect was identified as a man wearing full-face makeup, a dress, and women's shoes. He was also carrying a purse. He opened the purse and removed an envelope, which contained a demand note, and displayed it to the teller. The note threatened that he would shoot the teller. The suspect also displayed a black handgun in the purse. The suspect was given US currency, after which he fled the bank to the listed vehicle and was not located.

The suspect was described as having slight facial hair. He wore a black nylon cap, a black dress with blue and white flowers, a black long-sleeved shirt, and black women's sandals. He carried a black leather or plastic purse with stitching and a silver metal clasp.

On June 15, 2015, at approximately 12:29 p.m., the suspect entered the same TCF Bank, approached the teller counter, and produced a demand note. The suspect motioned to his waistband area, indicating he was armed with a gun. The teller gave the suspect US currency with a GPS tracker, then the suspect fled the bank. The tracker was discovered discarded nearby. The suspect fled the area in the listed vehicle.

The suspect was described as wearing a grey "Under Armour" baseball hat, a black v-neck shirt with a long sleeve white t-shirt underneath, and blue jeans.
