CAUTION

On June 27, 2015, at approximately 10:40 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Arizona Federal Credit Union located at 5505 West Bell Road in Glendale, Arizona. He proceeded to the customer waiting line and was called to the teller counter, where he placed the briefcase he was carrying. The suspect then removed a handgun from inside the briefcase and pointed it at the teller, demanding money.

The suspect is believed to be a Hispanic or Native American male, and wore a white hard hat, black sunglasses, an orange long-sleeved shirt with an orange traffic vest worn over the top, and carried a black briefcase with silver trim.

On August 8, 2015, at 11:04 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Ranch Market Grocery Store located at 3223 West Indian School Road in Phoenix, Arizona, and proceeded to the First Convenience Bank inside. The suspect waited in the customer line until he was called to the teller counter. The suspect verbally demanded money from the teller and held a black plastic bag and a small black handgun. The teller gave the suspect currency, then the suspect ordered the employees to go to a back office in the bank.

The suspect was described as a White male in his 40s, 5'8" to 5'10" tall, 170 pounds, with possible burn or scarred skin in the facial area. He wore a tan straw hat, a multi-colored

bandanna under the hat, black sunglasses, an orange traffic vest worn over the top of a black long-sleeved t-shirt, and blue jeans.

On October 3, 2015, at 10:25 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Walmart store located at 5605 West Northern Avenue in Glendale, Arizona. He proceeded to the Academy Bank branch inside the store and waited in the customer line. The suspect was called to the teller counter, at which time he produced a handgun and verbally demanded money from two tellers and a customer. After obtaining the money, the suspect exited the store and ran to a vehicle nearby.

The suspect was described as a light-skinned Native American male, 5'11" tall, 170 pounds, wearing makeup on his face. He wore a tan, straw, farmer-style hat, dark sunglasses, a dark green or grey long-sleeved shirt, blue jeans, and white tennis shoes.

On October 24, 2015, at 11:27 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Walmart store located at 7975 West Peoria Avenue in Peoria, Arizona. He proceeded to the Desert Schools Federal Credit Union branch inside, produced a handgun, and demanded money. The suspect was given currency then fled the store.

The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, 40 to 50 years old, 5'8" to 6'0" tall, 150 to 170 pounds, wearing a dark colored fedora-style hat, a long-sleeved button-up dress shirt with vertical white and grey stripes, blue jeans, and white tennis shoes.

On December 12, 2015, at approximately 10:16 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Walmart store located at 5250 West Indian School Road in Phoenix, Arizona. After entering, the suspect walked past the checkout registers and looped around the front of the store and walked directly to the Desert Schools Federal Credit Union branch inside. The suspect sat in a chair at the teller counter and inquired about opening an account. He then displayed a black semi-automatic handgun, which he pointed at the teller. He also produced a black plastic bag. The suspect announced the robbery, held up the black plastic bag, and demanded all the money. The suspect then approached a second teller robbed them as well.

The suspect was described as a White male, 40 to 45 years old, 5'10" to 6' tall, 165 pounds, wearing a blue hooded sweatshirt with a front zipper and a white "muscle" shirt worn underneath, black sunglasses, blue jeans, and black shoes with white soles.
