UNKNOWN BANK ROBBERS



DESCRIPTION

Remarks: All of the subjects wore masks and hoodies obscuring most, but not all, of their facial features. Two wore white or light gray hooded sweatshirts and one suspect wore a black hooded jacket/sweatshirt.

Vehicle Information: A green van was used as the getaway car.

Weapon Used: All three suspects carried firearms.

CAUTION

On June 12, 2015, at approximately 3:40 p.m., four unidentified individuals robbed the Wells Fargo Bank Branch located at 560 Walnut Avenue in Greenfield, California. Three entered the bank brandishing firearms and threatened employees and customers. One unidentified subject remained in a getaway car. The investigation is being worked jointly between the FBI and the Monterey County District Attorney's Office.

REWARD

There is a substantial reward being offered for information leading to the bank robbers' arrest and prosecution.
