### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** 6'0"

**Remarks:** The suspect wore a grey hoodie, medium colored blue jeans, and multi-patterned black and white hat.

### CAUTION

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Pittsburgh Division and the Pittsburgh Bureau of Police are seeking the public's assistance in identifying the unknown male responsible for robbing the First Commonwealth Bank, 501 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, on October 20, 2015, around 3:40 p.m. The robber may have been in McDonald's prior to the robbery. He used a note and placed an unknown amount of money into a McDonald's bag. He is described as being in his mid to late 40s, having salt and pepper stubble on his face, and wearing a grey hoodie, medium colored blue jeans, and multi-patterned black and white hat.
