UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



DESCRIPTION

Height: 5'10" to 6'0"

Sex: Male

Remarks: The suspect wore a red, black, and white custom motorcycle helmet with a black sun shield, a black vest worn over top of a grey hooded sweatshirt, and off-white gardening gloves. He carried a red shopping bag.

Weapon Used: Black semi-automatic handgun

Weight: 185 pounds

Age: Unknown

CAUTION

On November 24, 2015, at approximately 8:55 a.m., an unknown suspect entered the Arizona Central Credit Union located at 3550 South Price Road in Tempe, Arizona. He was armed with a black semi-automatic handgun, which he held in his left hand and pointed at the bank tellers while demanding money. The tellers gave the suspect currency, after which he exited the bank and fled to a motorcycle parked nearby before fleeing in an unknown direction.
