DESCRIPTION

Remarks: Suspect #1 is described as a White male, approximately 5'10", weighing approximately 180 pounds. He has an average build and appeared to be in his late 20s. He may have a thin beard. Suspect #2 is described as a White male, approximately 5'6", weighing approximately 160 pounds. He has a slight build and appeared to be in his mid-20s.

Weapon Used: Black semi-automatic pistols

CAUTION

On December 21, 2015, an unidentified male entered the Umpqua Bank located at 1211 South Pearl Street in Tacoma, Washington. He wore a black North Face jacket, carried a red-and-gray bag, and was armed with a pistol. He demanded money from the tellers then fled the bank on foot.

On December 23, 2015, an unidentified male entered the KeyBank located at 8402 Pacific Avenue in Tacoma, Washington. He was dressed in the same clothes as the December 21st robbery, and wore gloves and a mask as well. The unknown suspect also carried the same bag. He waited in a teller line until a teller opened a cash drawer for another customer. He then rushed to the counter and demanded money. He exited the bank on foot, ran across the street, and robbed the Columbia Bank located at 201 South 84th Street in Tacoma, Washington. He then fled on foot.

On December 28, 2015, two unidentified males entered the Umpqua Bank located at 109 35th Ave SE in Puyallup, Washington. Suspect #1 was wearing similar clothes and carried the same bag as the suspect in the first three robberies. Suspect #2 wore red pants and a gray hooded sweatshirt. Suspect #1 demanded money from the tellers, while Suspect #2 acted as a lookout.
