## UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** 5'9" to 6'0"

**Sex:** Male

**Race:** White

**Remarks:** The suspect had "scruffy" facial hair and was missing teeth. He wore a red fisherman-style hat; a tattered, off-white, striped, short-sleeved button-up shirt;

and blue jeans. The unknown suspect carried a plastic bag, a black handgun, and a ball of white material he used to wrap around his face.

**Weapon Used:** Black semi-automatic handgun.

**Weight:** 160 to 180 pounds

**Build:** Medium

**Age:** 40 to 50 years old

### CAUTION

On October 14, 2015, an unknown suspect entered the Compass Bank located at 4707 East Grant Road in Tucson, Arizona. The unknown suspect waited by the door for a few minutes then approached the teller counter. He then took out a ball of white material and wrapped it around his face. The suspect spoke to the three tellers and indicated it was a robbery and he wanted all of the cash out of their drawers. The suspect pulled a gun out and reportedly said the following: he did not want any ink packs; he was not messing around; he was not afraid to use this (gun); his friend was waiting in the car; and that the robbery was a suicide mission and he was not going back to prison. The suspect exited the bank on foot.
