DESCRIPTION

Height: 5'8" to 5'11"

Sex: Male

Build: Slender

Age: 20s

Remarks: The Incognito Bandit is described as an African-American male with a slender build. In nearly all cases, he is dressed in all black or dark colors, wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt or jacket, a ski mask, sunglasses, black gloves, and socks covering his shoes. On one occasion, he was dressed in a hooded sweatshirt with a U.S. Army logo. In six out of eight robberies, the suspect was armed with a black semi-automatic handgun.

CAUTION

On Thursday, November 10, 2016, at approximately 1:21 p.m., the Marlborough Savings Bank, located at 71 Boston Post Road, Marlborough, Massachusetts, was robbed by an unknown male. The suspect verbally demanded money from two tellers and fled the bank on foot.

It is believed the same individual is responsible for at least seven similar robberies across Massachusetts between September 5, 2015 and October 7, 2016, occurring in Woburn, Arlington, Waltham, Stoughton, Billerica, Bedford and Wayland.

REWARD

The FBI is offering a monetary reward of up to \$20,000 for information leading to the identification, arrest, and prosecution of the person responsible for these robberies.
