DESCRIPTION

Sex: Male

Remarks: The suspect wore a black suit, white shirt, black Kangol hat, and sunglasses.

Vehicle Information: The suspect utilized a bicycle.

Weapon Used: The suspect alluded to possessing an improvised explosive device, while displaying an electronic button/switch that had a wire running up his sleeve.

CAUTION

On May 18, 2015, at approximately 4:35 p.m., an unknown male suspect robbed the Regional Federal Credit Union, located at 7144 Kennedy Avenue, Hammond, Indiana. The suspect approached the teller, provided a black garbage bag, demanded money, and alluded to possessing an improvised explosive device. An electronic button/switch that had a wire running up the suspect's sleeve was observed at the time of the robbery. The teller complied, and the suspect fled the area utilizing a bicycle.
