CAUTION

On Friday, March 11, 2016, law enforcement agencies responded to a bank robbery at the Home Federal Bank of Tennessee located at 2940 South Mall Road NE in Knoxville, Tennessee. At approximately 9:25 a.m., the branch was robbed by a heavysset White male who drove a black or dark blue 2015 Toyota Camry. The unknown suspect obtained an undetermined amount of money and a red currency dye pack was activated when the he left the bank.

This matter is being investigated by the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) Safe Streets Task Force, which is comprised of the FBI, the Knoxville Police Department (KPD), the Knox County Sheriff's Office (KCSO), and the Knoxville Police Department's Violent Crime Unit.

All defendants are presumed innocent unless or until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
