DESCRIPTION

Vehicle Information: During the March 4, 2016, robbery, the suspect entered a 1994 to 2004 black Chevrolet S-10 pickup truck or a GMC Sonoma pickup truck. During the April 8, April 19, and March 10, 2016, robberies, the suspect's vehicle was described as a 1996 to 1999 Pontiac Bonneville, dark in color.

Weapon Used: Black semi-automatic handgun

CAUTION

On Friday, March 4, 2016, around 5:41 p.m., an unknown suspect ("Suspect 1") robbed Parkway Bank at 4731 East Union Hills Drive in Phoenix, Arizona. The suspect was armed with a black handgun. The suspect placed an unknown amount of money in a black drawstring bag then fled the bank in the 1994 to 2004 black Chevrolet S-10 or GMC Sonoma pickup truck, which was driven by another unknown suspect.

"Suspect 1" was described as a White or Hispanic male, 25 to 35 years old, 5'7", and 220 pounds.

On April 8, 2016, at approximately 3:50 p.m., a second unknown suspect ("Suspect 2") entered the UMB Bank at 16210 North Scottsdale Road in Phoenix, Arizona. She exited the bank and entered a dark-colored 1996 to 1999 Pontiac Bonneville and drove out of the parking lot. Approximately 30 minutes later, bank employees observed the same vehicle in the parking lot and watched as "Suspect 1" entered the bank, armed with a

black semi-automatic handgun, and demanded money. The suspect fled with an undisclosed amount of money.

In this instance, "Suspect 1" was described as a White or Hispanic male of unknown age, 5'9" tall, 200 pounds.

"Suspect 2" was described as a White female in her 30s, 5'5" with a thin build.

On April 19, 2016, at approximately 10:50 a.m., "Suspect 2" entered the Parkway Bank located at 4731 East Union Hills Road in Phoenix, Arizona, then left in a 1996 to 1999 Pontiac Bonneville. The vehicle returned to the bank at 12:23 p.m. and parked in front of the bank. An employee noticed the vehicle, walked to the entrance, and was confronted by "Suspect 1," who was armed with a black handgun and demanded money. The suspect placed the money into a bag and fled the scene in the listed vehicle, which was being driven by "Suspect 2."

"Suspect 1" was described as a male of unknown race, 40 to 50 years old, 5'8" to 5'11" tall, weighing 200 pounds.

Suspect 2 was described as a White female in her 30s, 5'6" tall, 150 pounds.

On Tuesday, May 10, 2016, at approximately 1:30 p.m., "Suspect 1" robbed the Johnson Bank located at 8700 East Pinnacle Peak Road, Suite 100, in Scottsdale, Arizona. He was armed with a black handgun, and fled in what is believed to be a 1996 to 1999 Pontiac Bonneville.

On Thursday, June 2, 2016, just before 6:00 p.m., an unknown male robbed Chase Bank at 4757 E. Greenway RD. in Phoenix, Arizona. The suspect was armed with a black handgun. He was a White male, wearing a wig, hat, mask and long pants. He fled with an undisclosed amount of money.

REWARD

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of both suspects involved in these robberies.

Parkway Bank, a non-governmental organization, is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of both suspects involved in these robberies. The FBI has no involvement in the administration of this reward or any of its governing terms or conditions.
