### DESCRIPTION

**Height:** 5'8" to 6'0"

**Build:** Medium

**Complexion:** Dark

**Age:** Late 40s to Mid 50s

**Remarks:** The robber is described as a Black male, late 40s to mid 50s, tall, skinny, dark-skinned, possibly having a mole on his right cheek, wearing glasses, a brown floppy or fedora hat, dark suit and collared shirt with no tie, nice shoes, carrying a black leather-type duffel bag. During both incidents, the robber pulled a stocking type mask down over his face to conceal his identity.

**Scars and Marks:** The suspect may have a mole or birthmark on his right cheek.

**Weapon Used:** Black semi-auto handgun

**Sex:** Male

**Eyes:** Brown

**Race:** Black
