Remarks: The Camo Bandit is described as an African-American male with a lean, muscular build, and a mustache. In every instance, he wears a cap and sunglasses. On two occasions, the suspect wore a camouflage hat. In his last four robberies, the Camo Bandit threatened the teller with a gun, although no gun was shown.

CAUTION

On Friday, October 14, 2016, at approximately 3:56 p.m., the Santander Bank, located at 6 Francis Street, Boston, Massachusetts, was robbed by an unknown male. The suspect presented the teller with a note and threatened a gun. It is believed the same individual is responsible for at least five similar robberies between June 29, 2016 and October 12, 2016, in the Dorchester, Hyde Park and Downtown sections of Boston, Massachusetts.
