Remarks: The subject has concealed his face for all the robberies using a mask, pillowcase, or bandana. He has also worn a variety of hats, including a large straw hat, dark-colored bucket hat, and black baseball cap with white "Taylormade" logo. He favors suits & ties, hooded sweatshirts, and lightweight jackets. He is thought to wear eyeglasses at least some of the time.

Vehicle Information: He is believed to own or have access to a 1998-2007 white Chevrolet Silverado or GMC Sierra base model pickup truck with a white cap over the bed. He may have previously owned or had access to a dark-colored Volvo sedan and a teal BMW sedan.

Weapon Used: The subject carries or wears a black semi-automatic handgun.
