On June 22, 2016, at approximately 3:45 p.m. an unknown suspect robbed a US Bank located at 2140 West Grant Road in Tucson, Arizona. The suspect put a plastic grocery bag on the counter and told the teller to put money in the bag, "preferable large bills." During the robbery, the suspect had his phone up to his face as if he was in a conversation.

On October 18, 2016, at approximately 5:55 p.m. the same suspect robbed a US Bank located at 4752 East Sunrise Drive in Tucson, Arizona. The suspect said his momma told him to get money and told the teller to fill the bag with money and to give him the blue ones.
