DESCRIPTION

Height: Approximately 5'10" to 6'0" **Weight:** Approximately 165 to 180 pounds

Remarks: The suspect wore a dark baseball cap, an auburn wig with a ponytail, sunglasses, a white painters mask, a light long-sleeved shirt, light blue overalls, and brown work boots.

Weapon Used: On October 13, 2016 the suspect used a black semi-automatic handgun. On October 18, 2016 the suspect used a silver revolver. On October 26, 2016 the suspect used a black semi-automatic handgun.

CAUTION

On October 13, 2016, at approximately 3:58 p.m. an unidentified suspect robbed Washington Federal located at 4910 East Broadway Boulevard in Tucson, Arizona. The suspect approached the counter and pointed a black handgun at the teller and demanded cash. The suspect spread the cash on the counter and demanded more from the other tellers.

On October 18, 2016, at approximately 11:45 a.m. the same suspect robbed the Tucson Federal Credit Union located at 3801 E Speedway Blvd in Tucson, Arizona. The suspect approached the counter, pointed a silver revolver at the teller, and demanded the cash. The suspect spread the cash on the counter and demanded more from the other tellers.

On October 26, 2016, at approximately 3:00 p.m. the same suspect robbed the Wells Fargo Bank located at 6920 E Sunrise Dr, in Tucson, Arizona. The suspect pointed a black handgun at the greeter and walked the greeter from teller to teller and demanded the case.

Two suspects were subsequently identified and arrested for the three captioned robberies. One suspect entered the banks and the other suspect drove the getaway vehicle.
