CAUTION

On October 27, 2016, at approximately 9:32 a.m., law enforcement agencies responded to an armed bank robbery at the Capital Bank at 136 Concord Road, Farragut, Tennessee. Reports indicate that a masked man entered the Capital Bank, brandished a semi-automatic handgun and demanded money from the bank employees. After obtaining an undetermined amount of money, the suspect fled the scene.

REWARD

A reward is being offered for information that leads to the arrest of this individual.

SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS

Anyone with information is asked to call the Knoxville FBI at 865-544-0751 or the KCSO at 865-215-2243. This matter is being investigated jointly by the FBI Safe Streets Task Force composed of the FBI, KPD and KCSO, and the KCSO Major Crimes Unit. All defendants are presumed innocent unless or until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
