UNKNOWN BANK ROBBER



DESCRIPTION

Height: 5'02"

Sex: Female

Remarks: The subject wore a long, dark wig, dark yoga pants, dark gray zip-up sweater and black shoes with white soles. The subject carried a large black shoulder bag.

Vehicle Information: Subject appeared to be on foot.

Weapon Used: Large, black semi-automatic handgun.

CAUTION

On October 24, 2016, an unknown, White female entered the BMO Harris bank branch located at 7000 W. Greenfield Ave in West Allis, Wisconsin. The subject waited in front of the teller counters and then approached a teller. The subject produced a demand note that requested money and threatened harm. The subject placed a bag on the counter and pointed a large, square semi-automatic handgun at the teller. The teller placed money in the bag and the subject exited the bank and fled on foot.

On November 1, 2016, an unknown White female entered the Bank Mutual branch located at W178N9379 Water Tower Pl in Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin. She approached the teller counter and produced a demand note that requested 50 and 100 dollar bills and threatened to kill the tellers. The subject then displayed a large, black handgun. The teller complied and the subject ran out of the bank and fled southbound on foot.
