# UNKNOWN BANK ROBBERS



## DESCRIPTION

**Sex:** Male

**Race:** Black

**Remarks:** Suspect #1 is described as a Black male in his 20s, 6'2", 180 pounds, wearing a black mask, dark clothing, black gloves, and sunglasses. Suspect #2 is described as a Black male in his 20s, 6'0", 175 to 180 pounds wearing black clothing, a black mask, black gloves, and a ball cap with the Maryland flag design on the bill. Suspect #3 is described as a Black male wearing black clothing and sunglasses.

**Vehicle Information:** Acura MDX, Md registration 3AZ9574, stolen earlier in the morning

**Weapon Used:** 2 black semi-automatic handguns

## CAUTION

On November 22, 2016, three males entered the PNC Bank at 1000 Fleet St in Baltimore City, Maryland. One suspect grabbed a customer who was at the ATM in the lobby, put a gun to his head, and pulled him into the bank, followed by another suspect. They approached the teller area at which time the second suspect jumped the teller counter and pointed a gun at tellers, taking money from their vaults. An additional suspect remained by the front door as a "look out". After obtaining money, the second suspect jumped back over the counter, and he, along with the suspect holding the customer, ran out of the bank, followed by the look-out. The suspects fled the area in a stolen Acura SUV.
