### DESCRIPTION

**Sex:** Male

**Race:** White

**Remarks:** Suspect #1 is described as a White male, approximately 5'10" with a medium build. He wore a gray hooded sweatshirt, a longer-style black winter coat with a zipper on the front, and black sweatpants. His face was covered with a black mask around the mouth and black sunglasses. He wore New Balance tennis shoes with orange soles and carried what appeared to be a newly-purchased plain canvas bag. Suspect #2, who was referred to as "Mac" by Suspect #1, is described as a White male, approximately 5'8" to 5'10" with a medium-to-slender build. He wore a gray hooded sweatshirt under a black Under Armour-style jacket with stripes along the sleeves, and gray-stripped Nike sweatpants. His face was covered with a ski mask and sunglasses, and he wore white tennis shoes with black stripes across the top.

**Weapon Used:** Suspect #1 was armed with a black frame handgun. Suspect #2 was armed with a black semi-automatic handgun.

### CAUTION

On February 15, 2019, at approximately 10:56 a.m., two unknown male subjects entered the Equity Bank located at 6200 Northwest 63rd Terrace in Kansas City, Missouri. The take-over style robbery included the subjects making an oral demand for cash and brandishing firearms. No injuries were reported. The two unknown subjects fled the bank with an undisclosed amount of money.

It is possible that the suspects parked in the east parking lot of St. Luke's Specialty Hospital and may have walked between the Twisted Fresh and Edible Arrangement retail locations prior to entering the bank, as well as when fleeing the scene.

## **REWARD**

The FBI is offering a reward of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the identification, arrest, and conviction of the individuals responsible for this bank robbery.
