CAUTION

- On April 4, 2019, at approximately 2:26 p.m., an unknown suspect entered the Pima Federal Credit Union, a federally insured institution located at 231 N. Pantano Road, Tucson, Arizona 85710. Once inside, the suspect approached the teller window and produced a demand note on a manila envelope. He stated that he had an explosive device and the teller complied with the demand. The suspect took the money and placed it in the manila envelope and fled the bank.
- On May 20, 2019, at approximately 1:54 p.m., an unknown suspect entered the National Bank of Arizona, a federally insured institution located at 5360 N. La Cholla, Tucson, Arizona 85741. Once inside, the suspect approached the teller window and produced a demand note on a manila envelope. The suspect brandished a black handgun in his waistband, said to the effect of, "I'm not messing around" and demanded the money. The bank teller provided U.S. currency. The suspect placed the money inside the manila envelope, exited the bank on foot and fled from the scene.
- On June 28, 2019, at approximately 3:20 p.m., an unknown suspect entered Bank of the West, a federally insured institution located at 3175 N Swan Road. Suite 101, Tucson, Arizona 85712. Once inside, the suspect approached the teller window and produced a demand note on a manila envelope. He stated that he had a gun and he didn't want to hurt anyone. The bank teller provided U.S. currency.

The suspect took the money and placed it in the manila envelope and fled the bank.

- On August 8, 2019, at approximately 3:02 p.m., an unknown suspect entered the Wells Fargo Bank located at 1090 East Ray Road in Chandler, Arizona. Once inside, the suspect approached the teller counter and presented a robbery demand note written on blue paper with black ink. The suspect mumbled a request, but the victim teller could not understand, so another teller was called over to assist. At that time, the suspect brandished a black handgun and stated that he wanted the money. The suspect also discreetly pointed the handgun at an unaware customer, advising the victim tellers that they needed to hurry up or the customer would be in danger. Both victim tellers complied with the robbery demand and provided a known amount of U.S. currency. After obtaining the money, the suspect fled from the bank towards the south.
